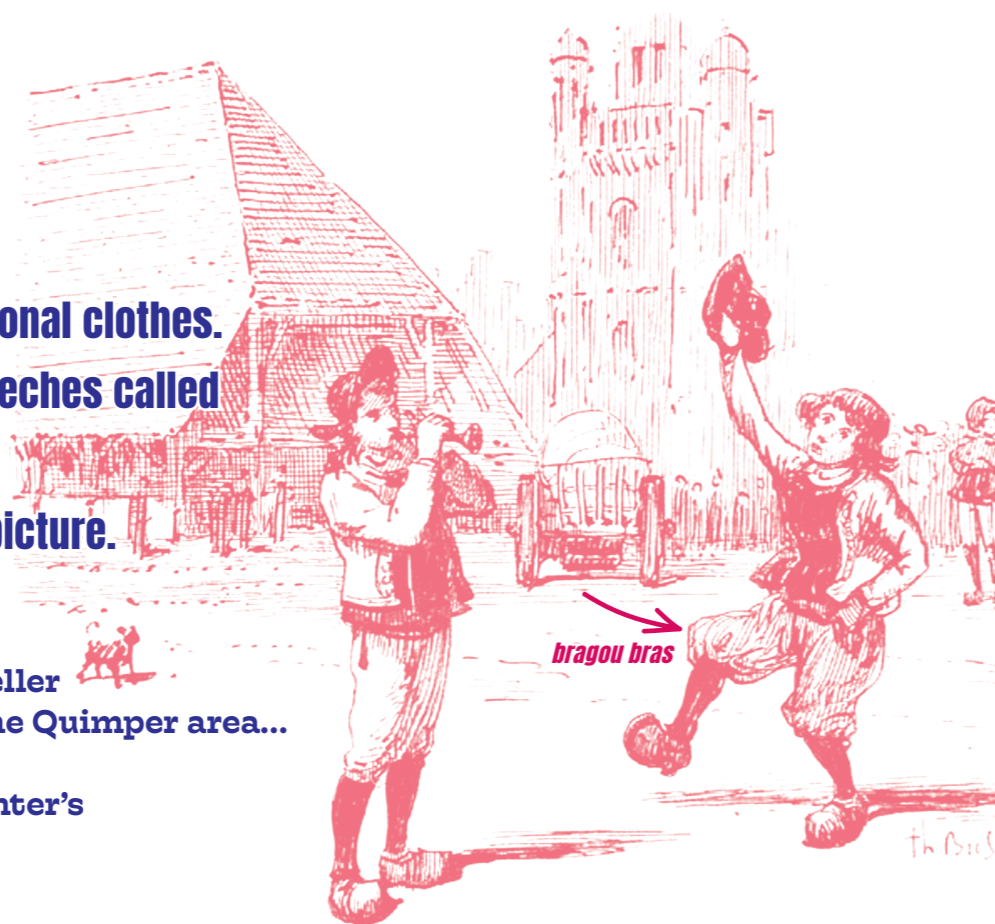
## ROOM 5 → 6 → 7 Puzzle 3

A clue is hidden near the picture.

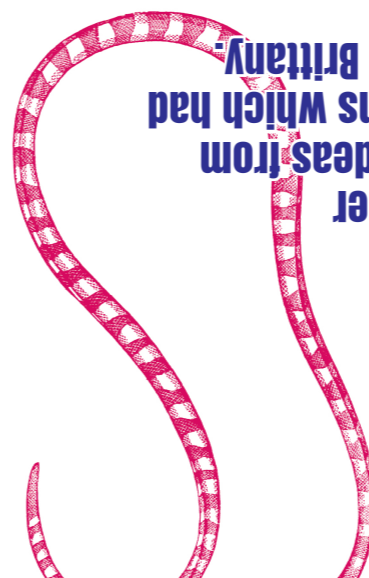


A clue is hidden below

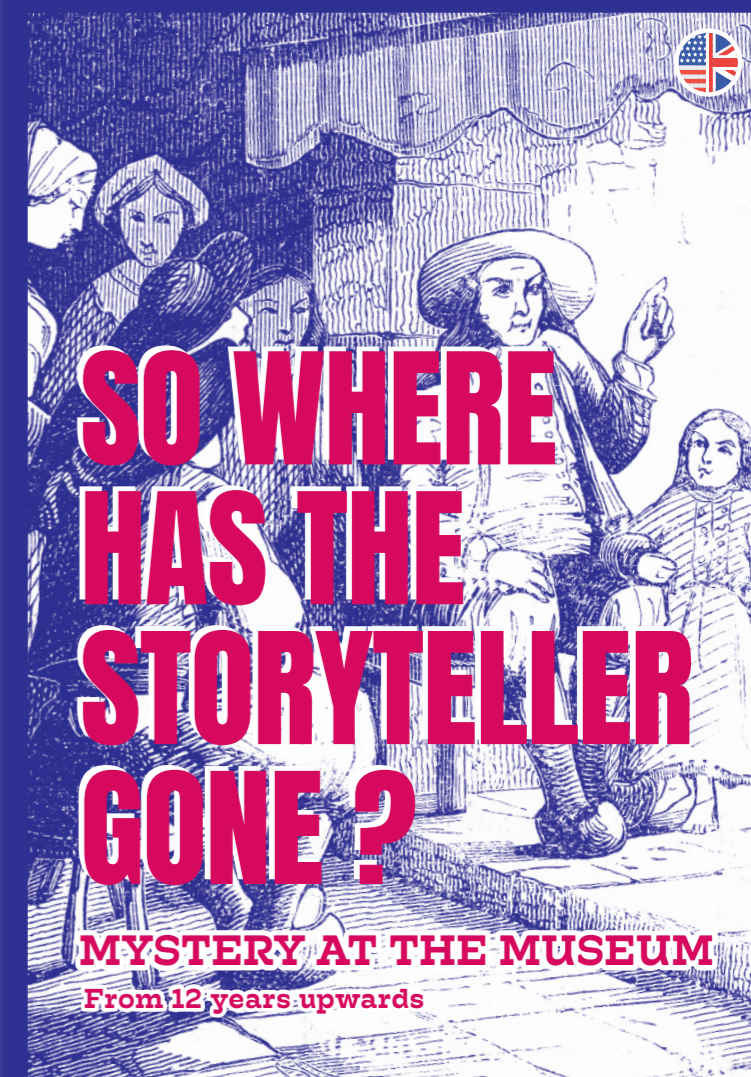
The answer to one of the questions can be found in a
